By participating, entrants accept and agree to abide by and be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of Rodeo Austin, which are final and binding in all respects and not subject to appeal.

1. Contest Schedule. The contest will begin on Friday, January 14, 2022 at 1:00 p.m. Central Standard Time (CST) and end on Tuesday, February 15, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. CST.

2. Eligibility. The Contest is open to individuals who are legal residents of the 50 United States or the District of Columbia. Proof of residency and age may be required. Entrants/performers must be willing and able to perform publicly at the Rodeo Austin – March 12 through March 26, 2022 (exact date TBD) at the Travis County Exposition Center located at 7311 Decker Lane, Austin, Texas 78726.

3. Contest Requirements. The contest is open to all ages. Videos must be a cappella by an individual and not a duet or group. Entries must not exceed 3 minutes in length and must be presented on video in English; no audio only submissions will be accepted. Videos DO NOT need to be from actual rodeo performance, home videos will be accepted. By uploading the video entry, you agree that your video entry conforms to the Official Rules, and that Rodeo Austin, in its sole discretion, may remove your video entry and disqualify you from the Contest if it believes that your entry fails to conform to the Official Rules of the Contest. In addition, the Nominee warrants and represents that the Video Entry (a) is original and has been legally created, (b) does not infringe the intellectual property, privacy or

publicity rights or any other legal or moral rights of any third party. Limit one (1) Video Entry per person. A Video Entry may only be submitted once. Once an entrant submits a Video Entry, the Video Entry becomes final and may not be modified or edited. All entries become property of Rodeo Austin and none will be returned. Rodeo Austin reserves the right to disqualify any entries by persons determined to be tampering with or abusing any aspect of the Contest.

4. Selection of Winners.

The panel will select the top entrants and contact those individuals to audition live in front of the panel. Date to be determined.

5. Participation. By participating, Entrants agree to be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of Rodeo Austin. Rodeo Austin reserves the right in its sole discretion to suspend, modify or terminate the Contest.

6. Copyright. By entering the Contest, each Entrant grants to Rodeo Austin an exclusive, royalty-free and irrevocable right and license to publish, print, edit or otherwise use the Entrant's submitted entry, in whole or in part, for any purpose and in any manner or media (including, without limitation, the Internet) throughout the world in perpetuity, and to license others to do so, all without limitation or further compensation.
