Thank you for participating in the Youth Art Show! The Youth Art Show takes place on the afternoon of Friday, February 10, 2023 and the top 40 placing pieces will be auctioned off either live or silent through March.

The Youth Art Show will take place at Palmer Events Center on the 2nd floor in the event space facing Riverside Drive and Town Lake.

- Art Winners Revealed and Art Reception.....Friday, February 10, 6:00 - 7:30 p.m.

Non-Placing Entries

If you do not receive a ribbon, you may take home your entry between 7:30 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. on February 10. If you did not attend the event and do not make the sale, you must make arrangements to pick up your entry from Rodeo Austin at a later time by contacting the Rodeo Austin Office at (512) 919-3000.

Silent Art Auction

If you are awarded one of the placings below, you will not attend the live auction March 25th. Rodeo Austin will facilitate the sale of your entry. Buyers will have the opportunity to bid on your work through an online bidding platform that will be open throughout the duration of the Rodeo Austin event in March. Entries are not guaranteed to sell. Results will be posted on the website approximately one week after the Art Show.

- Traditional Division: 3rd – 20th Place
- Photography Division: 3rd - 10th Place
- Digital Division: 3rd - 5th Place
- Sculpture/3D Division: 3rd - 5th Place

Live Art Auction

If you placed 1st or 2nd in your division, your entry will be placed in the Live Art Auction, Saturday, March 25th. The Live Art Auction will take place in conjunction with the Rodeo Austin Youth Auction on the Rodeo Austin Fairgrounds. The Art Auction will begin approximately 1:45 p.m. and will occur between the Market Steer Auction and the Market Lamb Auction. You will be asked to walk on stage with your entry at approximately 1:45 p.m. Professional or “cowboy chic” attire is encouraged but not required. Please view the schedule below.

- Poultry Auction – 9:00 a.m.
- Barrow Auction – 10:15 a.m.
- Steer Auction – 12:15 p.m.
- *Art Auction – Approximately 1:45 p.m.
- Lamb Auction – 2:00 p.m.
- Goat Auction – 3:30 p.m.

While you are on stage, the auctioneer will solicit bids for you. Adults are not permitted on stage; only the exhibitor may walk across. After receiving your bid, you may leave the event at any time.

Live Auction Passes and Parking
