This position effectively acts as a key member of the staff and a contributor to Rodeo Austin's overall strategy, event execution and culture. This is an opportunity to take on the challenge of working in a fast-paced, customer-driven non-profit; in an environment that is exciting, motivating, challenging and fun!

This is a full time exempt, benefits eligible position on our team that is available immediately to the right candidate. The expected commitment will be 40 hours per week during regular business hours, occasional evening meetings, and as needed on weekends and during Rodeo Austin events.

- Research, prospect and establish sponsorship leads with local, regional and national businesses through networking and cold calls
- Collaborate with full sponsorship team to create, design, develop, negotiate and execute official sponsorships
- Professionally articulate and present Rodeo Austin sponsorship opportunities
- Plan, organize and schedule sponsorship networking meetings, lunches, etc.
- Provide weekly reporting on items such as prospect meetings, new opportunities, project development and targeted leads
- Consistently maintain communication with current and potential sponsors to promote a high degree of interest, involvement, and enthusiasm for Rodeo Austin
- Identify and assist in developing sponsorship assets and proper valuations
- Evaluate market and brand research to generate new sponsorship inventory ideas and concepts
- Ensure all sponsorship elements are properly activated and fulfilled. Post show, work with sponsorship team to develop a detailed sponsorship recap for each sponsor
- Oversee department budgets and timelines
- Recruit and manage collegiate interns
- Assist the full Marketing, Sponsorship, Rodeo and Entertainment department with all event execution
- Assist Sponsorship and Marketing Officer with special projects as assigned
- Work in an fast paced, high energy office setting on a daily basis, while collaborating with passionate volunteers
- Represent the organization at official functions and events and networking events, or public relations activities
- Support the mission and values of Rodeo Austin at all times
