WHAT IS BBQ AUSTIN?

BBQ Austin is an open-invitation BBQ cook-off hosted by Rodeo Austin and sanctioned by the Champions Barbecue Alliance (CBA). Teams from all over the state of Texas come to compete in three sanctioned contests: Chicken, Brisket & Ribs. Competitors also have the option to compete in additional contests including Beans, DK's Jackpot, Bloody Mary & BBQ Sauce. Throughout the weekend, the public attends to enjoy BBQ, Bands & Beer! While battling for the title of best barbecue, teams also compete to raise the most monetary donations for Rodeo Austin using the donation buckets provided by the BBQ Austin Committee. Periodically, BBQ Austin Committee Members will enter team spaces to empty donation buckets and a running total of donation amounts will be kept throughout the weekend.

CHIEF COOK REQUIREMENTS

- Must be at least 18 years old and present for the entire duration of the event.
- Must abide by all CBA and BBQ Austin rules, regulations, and requirements.
- Must turn in only one entry on a given pit for each sanctioned contest category.
 - CBA-sanctioned categories include Chicken, Brisket, & Ribs.
 - Other BBQ Austin contest entries are optional and are purchased in advance.
- Must use the container provided by CBA.
 - No other containers will be accepted, judged, or scored.
- Registration must be paid IN FULL by Monday, January 13, 2025.
- Must be on the BBQ Austin grounds and checked in by 10:00am on Friday, March 7, 2025.

TEAM SPACE INFO

- Space registration does not include tents, tables, chairs, etc.
 - These items should be rented separately (we recommend Peerless Tents) if you so choose.
- If putting up a tent larger than **400 square feet with sides** or **700 square feet without sides**, teams are required to purchase and complete a Travis County Fire Marshal Tent Permit.
 - Permits are \$240 and only one is needed per total tent space larger than the required sizes.
 - Permits will be purchased and completed during registration and will need to be present throughout the duration of BBQ Austin.
- Any holes made in the asphalt/ground as a result of tent staking must be filled with like-material.
 - If holes are not filled, teams will be subject to a \$50 fine per hole found.
- Teams are responsible for providing 100 feet of water hose(s) and 100 feet of extension cord(s) as amenities may not be located directly behind the team's space.

 - Last day to receive Regular Rate pricing.
- Monday, January 13, 2025 at 11:59 PM
 - Registration closes; includes add-ons, RV Permits, etc.
- Wednesday, March 5, 2025 at 2:00 PM
 - Team Load-In begins.
- Friday, March 7, 2025 after 10:00 AM
 - Any vehicles within the BBQ Austin event grounds are subject to being towed at owner's expense.
- Friday, March 7, 2025
 - BBQ Austin gates open:
 - 12:00-11:00pm
- Saturday, March 8, 2025
 - BBQ Austin gates open:
 - 11:00am-11:00pm
- Sunday, March 9, 2025
 - Teams may begin to tear down their spaces prior to the BBQ Austin Awards.
 - Exit gates will not be opened until the conclusion of the awards ceremony.
- Sunday, March 9, 2025 no later than 6:00 PM
 - All teams must be off the BBQ Austin grounds.

IMPORTANT RULES TO REMEMBER

- Any trash left in your team's space after load-out will result in a \$500 fine.
- RVs should be filled with water before they enter the BBQ Austin grounds.
 - Additional water fills/septic pumps are available but must be purchased in advance through registration.
- After load-in, teams will not be permitted to bring anything through the public gates.
 - If teams need to restock, they must use **Gate 2** (BBQ Team Entrance Only).
 - Teams will not be allowed to drive to their space to drop off supplies; everything must be carried in by hand from the team parking lot.
 - Glass bottles are not permitted on BBQ Austin event grounds.
- Teams cannot sell or mandate donations for alcoholic beverages.
 - Teams are required to **provide** food when alcohol is being served.
 - Teams are required to use an appropriate number of TABC-certified bartenders and at no time may a
 person under the age of 21 be served alcohol, even in the presence of a legal guardian.
 - Alcoholic beverage service to the general public must end at 12:00am each night of BBQ Austin.
- Each team must have at least one (1) 10lb fire extinguisher that is readily accessible to all team members.
- Ice tickets must be presented to obtain ice and are purchased in advance through registration.
- Anyone entering the BBQ Austin event grounds, including team members, must have a BBQ Austin admission ticket.
 - Team VIP wristbands alone do not admit guests into the event.
